PRE RIDE SAFETY CHECKLIST

- Staggered formation riding rules**
 You should be able to see eyes of the rider in front of you in their mirrors.
 Rider owns the whole lane they may need to move in front of you on corners or to avoid hazards.
- Keeping the group together**
 Follow staggered riding rules and maintain following distance
 Don't race away from stops or immediately increase speed at limit signs
- How to handle intersections**
 Don't race away from the intersection
 Look for spacing so more of the group can cross
 Emphasize each member is responsible for safely executing intersections
- Passing procedures**
 Cover two lane passing
 Cover 4 lane riding if applicable. Only sweep should move into another lane before the ride leader
- Leaving the group**
 If there is a planned leave be sure to alert the Road Captains at the stop prior,
 then ride near the sweep so that your leaving does not disrupt the group.
 If there is a sudden, unplanned need to leave please signal and pull safely to the side.
- Roadside Emergencies**
 Only sweep stops, rest follow ride leader to nearest safe area to pull over,
- What to do if separated**
 Don't panic, if route is simple, ride leader will look to slow or pull over, so you can catch up.
 If the route has turns, allow the sweep to lead until catching up with the main group.
- Parking**
 Clear lanes of traffic as early as possible
- Roadway Hazards**
 Will be pointed out using the hand (foot) signals
- Hand Signals**
 Slow Down Hazard in the road, left and right Right side lane hazard possible
 Speed Up Single File Double File Stop Left turn Right turn
